<p><i>Research assignment</i> 15 ECTS</p>	<p>Research assignment for exchange students</p> <p>During the application process, students should find their research topic and tutor via this link: Academic and research units</p> <p>Admission requires a confirmed tutor. Students should inform the International Relations Office and register their project via eSecretaria.</p> <p>The Research Assignment is assessed based on a formal presentation to the tutor and the submission of the final project via eSecretaria (in accordance with the academic calendar). <u>No public defense is required.</u></p>

<p><i>Master's Thesis</i> <i>30 ECTS - Modality A</i></p>	<p>Final Degree Project or Master's Thesis (MT). Modality A</p> <p>During the application process, students should find their research topic and tutor via this link: Academic and research units</p> <p>Admission requires a confirmed tutor. Students should inform the International Relations Office and register their project via eSecretaria.</p> <p>Master's thesis has to be defended at the ETSEIB following the academic regulations and calendar.</p> <p>Calendars</p>

<p><i>Exams</i></p>	<p>Course Assessments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Autumn semester: January ● Spring semester: June ● Re-evaluation (for both semesters): July <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <i>Important: Students must register for re-evaluation (REAVA) during the Spring semester enrolment period.</i>
<p><i>Transcript of Records</i></p>	<p>Official Transcript of Records are now issued in digital format and signed digitally. It also includes a secure verification code to ensure its authenticity.</p> <p>Students can download their transcripts directly from eSecretaria at the end of each semester after the Curricular Assessment (AC) date. Check Calendars for the specific dates.</p> <p><i>eSecretaria > Certificates > Academic certificates > Incoming mobility certificate (Digital signature)</i></p>
